

SDCES' Website Privacy Statement

Owens & Wright, Attorneys at Law/San Diego County Eviction Services ("SDCES") is committed to protecting your privacy and a safe online experience. This Statement of Privacy applies to the SDCES Web site and governs data collection and usage. SDCES will only share your information with outside parties in ways that are described in this privacy statement or if we are required to do so by law or in the good-faith belief that such action is necessary in order to conform to the edicts of the law, cooperate with law enforcement agencies, or comply with a legal process served on our web site. By using the SDCES website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

For registered members, SDCES collects personally identifiable information, such as your e-mail address, name, home or work address or telephone number. For non-registered visitors, SDCES also collects anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your ZIP code, age, gender, preferences, interests and favorites.

There is also information about your computer hardware and software that is logged by SDCES. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring Web site addresses. This information is used by SDCES for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the SDCES Web site. SDCES encourages you to review the privacy statements of Web sites SDCES may link to so that you can understand how those Web sites collect, use and share your information. SDCES is not responsible for the privacy statements or other content on Web sites outside of the SDCES Web site.

Use of your Personal Information

SDCES collects and uses your personal information to operate the SDCES Web site and deliver the services you have requested. SDCES may use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from SDCES and its affiliates. SDCES may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

SDCES does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties. SDCES may, from time to time, contact you on behalf of external business partners about a particular offering that may be of interest to you. In those cases, your unique personally identifiable information (e-mail, name, address, telephone number) is not transferred to the third party. In addition, SDCES may share data with trusted partners to help us perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail and provide customer support. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to SDCES, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

SDCES does not use or disclose sensitive personal information, such as race, religion, or political affiliations, without your explicit consent.

SDCES keeps track of the Web sites and pages our customers visit within SDCES, in order to determine what SDCES services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customized content and advertising within SDCES to customers whose behavior indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

SDCES Web sites will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on SDCES or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of SDCES; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of SDCES, or the public.

Use of Cookies

The SDCES Web site use "cookies" to help you manage your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a Web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. If you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to fully experience the interactive features of the SDCES services or Web sites you visit.

Security of your Personal Information

SDCES secures your personal information from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. SDCES secures the personally identifiable information you provide on computer servers in a controlled, secure environment, protected from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. When personal information (such as a credit card number) is transmitted to other Web sites, it is protected through the use of encryption, such as the Secure Socket Layer (SSL) protocol.

Changes to this Statement

SDCES will occasionally update this Statement of Privacy to reflect company and customer feedback. SDCES encourages you to periodically review this Statement to be informed of how SDCES is protecting your information.
